

## AID TO CONSTRUCTION

CONSTRUCTION TYPE	CONSTRUCTION COSTS (2022)
<b>NEW SERVICE DROP</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• \$400 aid to construction fee for each metered service</li> <li>• Required meter location is on the outermost sidewall of home including attached garages, must be within 10 feet from building corner nearest closest delivery point (Policy 310)</li> <li>• \$10/ft over 100 ft</li> <li>• \$10/ft for driveway crossings</li> <li>• \$800 for armor cable</li> </ul>
<b>APARTMENTS, COMMERCIAL, SUBDIVISIONS, AND AGRICULTURE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• \$1/amp connect fee</li> <li>• \$15/kVA of transformer capacity</li> <li>• Primary line extension allowance per Policy 304</li> <li>• \$1,000 per crossing for subdivision road bores</li> <li>• Service must be adjacent to a recorded public or private utility easement, or additional costs may apply</li> </ul>
<b>NEW DRAIN TILE PUMP, PASTURE PUMP, SIGNS, OR OTHER LOW-USAGE SERVICE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• \$1/amp connect fee</li> <li>• No line extension allowance per Policy 304</li> </ul>
<b>SERVICE CAPACITY UPGRADE, SINGLE- OR THREE-PHASE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• \$15/kVA of transformer capacity</li> <li>• \$1/Amp upgrade</li> <li>• Credit for existing transformer kVA</li> <li>• Additional charges may apply depending on the extent of revamp</li> </ul>
<b>PRIMARY REVAMP, SINGLE-PHASE TO THREE-PHASE SERVICE (POLICY 304)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide 500 ft of line extension at no cost</li> <li>• \$15/kVA of new net transformer capacity and \$1/amp</li> </ul>
<b>NEW SECURITY LIGHTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Member will pay 100% of the costs</li> </ul>
<b>COLD WEATHER CHARGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Nov. 1 - 14: \$5/trench foot</li> <li>• Nov. 15 - 30: \$10/trench foot</li> <li>• Dec. 1 – TBD by CCEC: \$16/trench foot</li> <li>• Cass County Electric Cooperative reserves the right to suspend cable installation due to weather or ground conditions.</li> </ul>

All services must follow policy 310 Conditions of Service (available at [CassCountyElectric.com](http://CassCountyElectric.com)). Additional charges may be assessed for bores, soil or weather conditions, or for any other unforeseen issues. Requests for power made after Oct. 15 may not make the current year's construction schedule.
